FACILITATOR GUIDE

Sample Session

Six sessions. One leader. No finance background required.

This sample includes the full six-session map, how a session runs, and Session One in its entirety.

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WHAT THIS IS

You do not have to be an expert to lead this

Most men's studies about money never get scheduled a second time. Not because the men were not interested. Because the leader was asked to teach a subject he was still figuring out himself, in front of men who knew him.

This guide removes that problem. Every session is written out. The questions are written out. What to do when the room goes quiet is written out. Your job is to open the room, ask what is on the page, and let the men talk.

COMPOUND is a book about identity. No session asks you to give financial advice or review anyone's numbers. If a man brings his numbers to you, the guide tells you what to say.



THE SIX SESSIONS

1	God Owns It All	Ownership, and the weight a man was never assigned
2	The Striving Man	Stage 1. The belief that everything depends on him
3	The Laws and the Warnings	What Scripture says, and the five patterns that wreck homes
4	The Habits of Wise Men	What faithful stewardship looks like on a Monday
5	Bringing Her In	Stages 3 and 4. From managing alone to leading a team
6	A Legacy That Liberates	Stage 5, the covenant, and what outlives him

HOW LONG EACH SESSION RUNS

Sixty to seventy-five minutes. Ten minutes to open, forty to forty-five in discussion, ten on the commitment, five to close in prayer. Groups of six to twelve men work best. Above twelve, split into two circles for the discussion block and come back together to close.

SESSION ONE

God Owns It All

Read before the session: the Introduction and Chapter One.

What this session is for: every man walks in believing his household rests on him. This session puts that belief on the table without shaming anyone for holding it. Nothing gets solved tonight. Something gets named.

OPEN THE ROOM

Read this aloud, then ask the first question and wait.

“The earth is the LORD’s, and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him.” Psalm 24:1, NLT

DISCUSSION

1. When you were growing up, what did the men around you seem to believe a husband was responsible for?
2. Eugene writes that the weight is not the money, it is the belief that all of it rests on him. Where do you notice that belief in an ordinary week?
3. If everything in your household belongs to God and you are managing it, what changes about your next financial decision?
4. What would it look like for you to lead your household well without being the source of it?

THE COMMITMENT

Each man names one thing out loud. One sentence about what he will stop carrying alone this week. Write them down. You come back to these in Session Six.

CLOSE

Pray, and keep it short. Thank God for what He has already provided to the men in the room. Ask for honesty between now and next week.

IF THIS HAPPENS

Nobody talks. Session One is the quietest. Answer question one yourself, honestly, in under ninety seconds, then ask the man on your left by name. One lap around the circle opens the room.

Someone asks you a money question. Usually about debt. Say you are not the guy to answer it, then hand it to the group: “Has anybody here walked through something like it?”

THAT WAS ONE OF SIX

Your men are ready before you are.

The full Facilitator Guide carries all six sessions written out the same way, with leader notes, an If This Happens page for every session, and the group tools for running a study start to finish.

Compound is what a husband was created to do with everything God provides.
